Need a Lift? Delaware County Public Transportation Guide Helps Residents Hitchin' a Ride  
*Map & Guide Details Delco Sights & Transport Services*

Delaware County Council, along with the Transportation Planning Department of Delaware County, has made the Delaware County Public Transportation Map and Guide available to county residents.

The guide serves as a reference to SEPTA's public transit system in Delaware County, as well as an information guide which details the location of colleges, shopping centers, hospitals, senior care facilities, parks and more. The guide even includes suggestions for residents wishing to incorporate bicycle use as a mode of transportation.

A significant portion of Delaware County is served by the SEPTA system, ensuring that residents have an enjoyable and environmentally friendly travel alternative to driving.

Side one of the guide details all bus, regional rail, trolley, and high-speed rail services in Delaware County, with certain routes in neighboring Chester, Montgomery Counties and the City of Philadelphia listed as well.

Each map also provides a guide to transit fares, regional rail stations, and all bus routes serving Delaware County. Information includes the frequency of bus service (the time between successive buses,) the number of parking spaces at train stations, parking permit requirements, ticket and pass prices, and on-board bicycle policies, as well as bicycle parking at regional rail stations.
