



Passport Fee Changes

Effective February 1, 2008

How to Use Fee Charts

ADULTS AGE 16 & OVER

	0	1	2	3
0	DOS + AF	20 + 25	40 + 50	60 + 75
1	10 + 25	30 + 50	50 + 75	70 + 100
2	20 + 50	40 + 75	60 + 100	80 + 125

DOS = Department of State
Passport Fee
AF = Acceptance Facility
Execution Fee

CHILDREN
AGE 15
& UNDER

Total Fees
70 + 100 = \$170

Question - Mr. & Mrs. Smith and their children Jim (Age 17) and Betty (Age 5) would like to apply for Passport Cards. How much should the Acceptance Agent charge the family?

1. Determine how many adults age 16 and over (3) and how many children age 15 and under (1).
2. Locate the number of adults in the top row, and the number of children in the left hand column.
3. Trace the correct row and column until your fingers meet in one box.
4. Add the Department of State (DOS) and Acceptance Facility (AF) numbers together for total amount.

Answer - The Acceptance Agent should charge the Smith family \$170 in total fees.
(\$70 to DOS and \$100 to AF)

Passport Book Age 16 and Over, DS-11	\$75	\$25	\$100
Passport Book Age 15 and Under, DS-11	\$60	\$25	\$85
Passport Book By Mail, DS-82	\$75	N/A	\$75
Passport Card Age 16 and Over, DS-11	\$20	\$25*	\$45
Passport Card Age 15 and Under, DS-11	\$10	\$25	\$35

* The \$25 Execution Fee is not charged when adults 16 and over with fully valid passport books apply for the passport card using a DS-82 form.
